## What is e-Reference?

Electronic Reference is the digital version of the printed reference collection which contains full text of articles as well as the bibliographic records which can be accessed locally or remotely via computer networks. The users can get access to these resources 24/7 a week. E-reference @ UBD which are available through the DiLibraryUBD Portal includes subscribed online dictionaries, encyclopedias, biographies, etc.

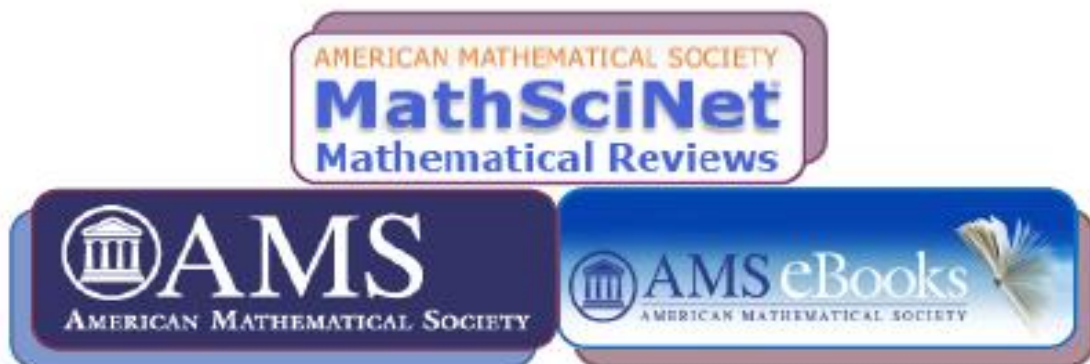

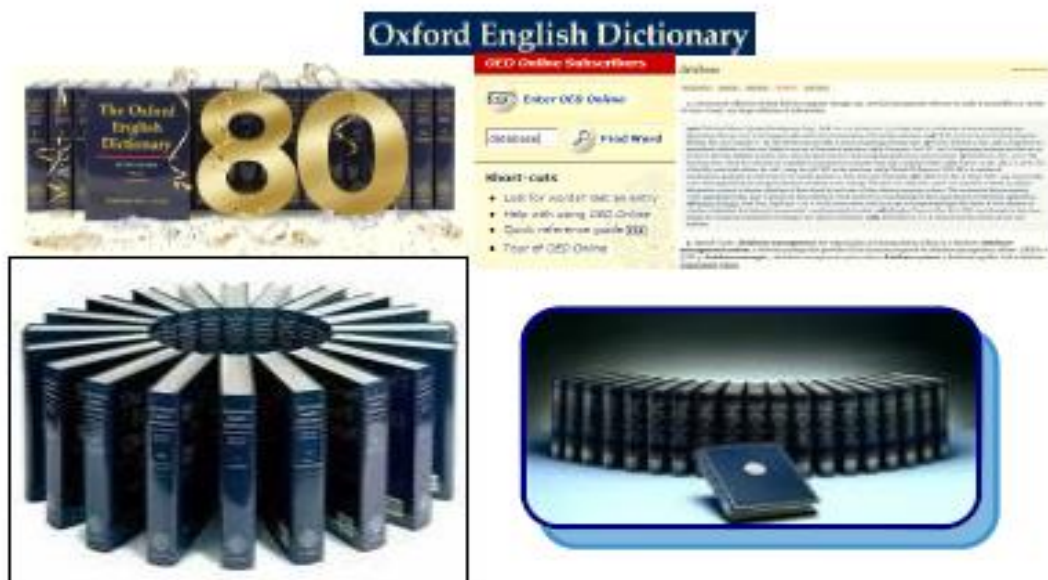
- **MathSciNet**
